Sapphire Stroller sold at Argos - recall

We have identified a fault with the above pushchair.

In a small number of cases the bolt that holds the frame together has come loose causing the pushchair to collapse. This could lead to the injury of any child in the pushchair at the time.

If you have an example of this pushchair

During rigorous control procedures it has been brought to Wahl's attention that in rare instances the Turbo Button on the James Martin Hand Mixer could operate when the speed selector switch is in the 0 (OFF) position, which could present a possible hazard.

WAHL***IKEA RUND Glass Mug - recall***

The following notice has been issued by the retailer:

IKEA kindly asks customers who have a RUND glass mug to immediately stop using the mug and bring it back to any IKEA store for full refund.

IKEA has received twelve reports worldwide of RUND glass mugs that have broken in use. Five of the reports stated that injury had occurred.

On receiving reports with glass breakage IKEA began an investigation which revealed variations in glass thickness.

As a precautionary measure IKEA has therefore decided to recall RUND glass mugs in all countries.

IKEA does not compromise on product safety and recommend all customers concerned to return the RUND glass mug.

The following notice has been issued by the manufacturer:

sport V2 / classic V1 - hinge cover

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

Consistent with our unwavering commitment to safety we are providing consumers with notice of a voluntary recall to repair of the now discontinued sport v2 and classic v1 strollers, manufactured between April 2008 and June 2010.

We are making available, free of charge, to all affected consumers a free self-fit hinge cover. This is in response to a number of reported cases in which the frame lock of a sport v2 (which shares a common hinge with the classic v1) was not utilised and an adult user caught a finger in the hinge mechanism, causing injury.

Of the phil&teds stroller range only these two strollers are affected by this recall to repair. All other models have different hinge mechanisms and are unaffected.

Safety is our first priority and through this voluntary effort we urge consumers to immediately obtain and fit the free kit which may be obtained via the [online order form](#) (opens in a new window).

phil&teds stresses that all users should read and adhere to the instruction manual which contains valuable safety tips and service recommendations.

Buggy identification methods:

1. The sport v2 and classic v1 were manufactured between March 2008 and May 2010.

2. Affected serial numbers (located on the inner face of the main hinge, underneath the seat):

- **Sport V2 affected serial numbers - 0308/0001 to 0510/0840**
- **Classic V1 affected serial numbers - 0308/0001 to 0510/0906**

3. The strollers have the codes 'SPv2' (sport v2) or 'E3C' (classic v1) printed on the wrist safety strap attached to the stroller handle
