

## **Disability and Anti-Bullying**

### **A one day multi-agency course**

#### **Will this course be useful to me in my job?**

This course has been developed as part of a joint campaign between the NSPCC and the BSCB which focused on disability and anti-bullying.

The course has been designed to enable staff, volunteers and carers who work with disabled children and children with special educational needs to be aware of bullying as an issue and know how to respond and intervene effectively.

#### **What does the course cover?**

The course will cover:

- Duties and responsibilities
- Defining bullying
- Bullying related to disabilities – vulnerability
- Being inclusive
- Prevention, protection and responding

#### **Who will present the course?**

The course will be presented by two trainers who are part of a network of anti-bullying and disability trainers who are supported by the BSCB, the NSPCC and the Bradford Anti-Bullying Network. The course has been designed and developed in partnership with the NSPCC and the Anti-Bullying Alliance.

#### **When will the course be held?**

The course will be a full day (09.30-16.30 with registration and refreshments from 09.00) and held on:
