



SAFEGUARDING DISABLED CHILDREN

A ONE DAY MULTI-AGENCY COURSE

Will this course be useful to me in my job?

Research has repeatedly shown that children who have a disability or learning difficulty are particularly vulnerable to abuse especially where their disability affects the way they communicate. It is important that these children are safeguarded. The day will be of interest to all people who have direct contact with children who may have these special needs and difficulty in communicating.

This is not a course for specialists but will be suitable for those people whose knowledge of this topic is basic or those who wish to acquire knowledge in this field

What will the course cover?

The course aims to

- Give further understanding of vulnerability
- Give further understanding of the effects disability can have on workers
- Explore protective strategies
- Share ideas and innovative practice
- Explore different forms of communication and emphasise the importance of working together
